

DECLARATION OF RoHS COMPLIANCE

Restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances (RoHS)

The Reformulation of RoHS 2011/65/Eu Directive of European Union (also known as RoHS2), coming into force on 21/07/11 and with effect from 02/01/13, restricts the use of hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment; these substances are reported below.

According to the information received from our suppliers, **FOXEL Electronics srl** declares that following products are in compliance with RoHS Directive 2011/65/Eu for the orders placed after the date of this certificate.

Compliance to RoHS Directive means that:

- our suppliers confirmed the compliance of used products (including those compliant by exoneration)
- rigorous and continuous processes are undertaken to check and log that information

Our suppliers can confirm the compliance because used products do not contain any of restricted substances reported in Attachment II of the Reformulation of RoHS Directive in concentrations higher than those permitted by the same Directive.

For the purposes of directive, in homogeneous materials the maximum concentration values by weight of restricted substances are:

Lead (Pb), Hexavalent Chromium (Cr VI), and Mercury (Hg)	0.1% (w/w)
Cadmium (Cd)	0.01% (w/w)
Polybrominated Biphenyls and Diphenylethers	0.1% (w/w)


